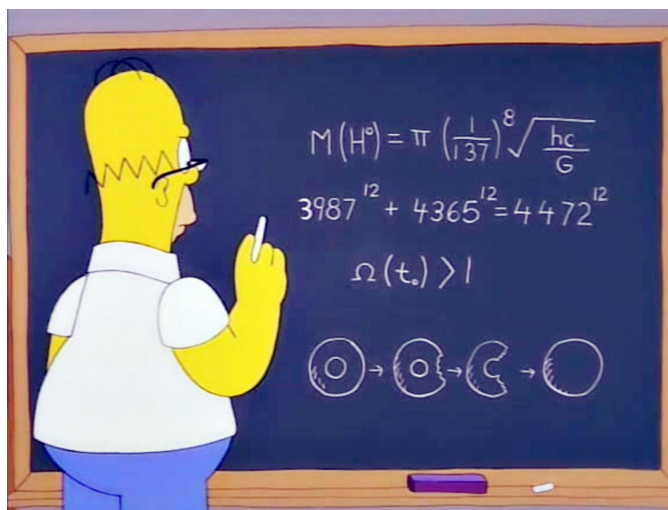


Figure 1: Homer’s blackboard, as used in Exercise 1.20.
